DECREE OF PARTIAL DISTRIBUTION

Decree of Partial Distribution. Based on the filings of record, it appears that there will be sufficient assets after the proposed distribution to pay all remaining obligations of the estate including debts and funeral charges of the decedent, taxes and expenses of administration.

THEREFORE, the Court **DECREES** the following property subject to any listed liens, mortgages, and/or other encumbrances:

In the event the assets remaining in the hands of the fiduciary thereafter are insufficient to satisfy the ultimate expenses and charges against the estate, those persons receiving these distributions shall be liable to repay the fiduciary as provided in 14 V.S.A. §1721(b).
