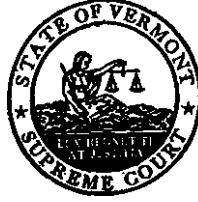

It is **your responsibility** to comply fully with the Rules of Admission to the Bar of the Vermont Supreme Court.

A petition for admission is a continuing application, and all information required must be corrected or supplemented and filed up to and including the date of admission. No petition is considered filed until received in the Vermont Board of Bar Examiners office.

The application deadline is May 1 for the July exam and December 1 for the February exam. Late filings must be accompanied by a written request showing extraordinary circumstances justifying failure to meet the filing deadline. Acceptance of the petition is at the discretion of the Board of Bar Examiners.
