Requirements for admission to the Vermont Bar include a written examination in three parts: the essay examination, the Multistate Bar Examination (MBE), and the Multistate Professional Responsibility Examination (MPRE). See § 6 of the [Rules of Admission to the Bar of the Vermont Supreme Court](#) for further details.

Each applicant must sit for the essay **and** Multistate Bar Examination parts of the examination at one administration unless that applicant has previously achieved a passing grade of 135 or higher on either part.

Fill out the following chart, if you have previous scores you wish to use to meet these requirements. **The scores from the MBE and Vermont essay may be retained for four consecutive administrations in which it was achieved.** The scores from the MPRE may be retained for seven years. If you have a score from another jurisdiction, you must arrange for those scores to be certified to the Vermont Board of Bar Examiners. **Your essay scores will not be released until a certified MBE score is received.**
