

## Admission under the New Hampshire and Maine Reciprocal Agreement

Lawyers who are active members of the New Hampshire or Maine state bar, have been actively engaged in the practice of law in New Hampshire or Maine for no less than three years immediately preceding this application for admission, are currently members in good standing in all jurisdictions where admitted, and are not under suspension or revocation nor currently subject to any disciplinary matter in any jurisdiction, may be admitted to the practice of law upon motion and without examination.

An applicant who has failed the Vermont bar examination within five years of the date of filing an application for admission under this section shall not be eligible for admission on motion.

In lieu of the law office study requirements of [§ 7\(d\)](#), you must certify below that you have attended at least fifteen hours of continuing legal education on Vermont practice and procedure in courses approved by the Board of Continuing Legal Education within one year prior to application for admission. **Self-study courses are limited to 9 of the 15 hours.**

Applicants may file an affidavit of attendance at other Vermont MCLE approved courses containing instruction on Vermont practice and procedure as part of their petition for admission without examination, with a request for approval by the Board of Bar Examiners as fulfilling those requirements. If the Board of Bar Examiners does not find that some or all of those courses meet the requirements, the applicant will be notified of which do not and have an opportunity to take other courses without penalty.
