Pursuant to the Rules of Admission to the Bar of the Vermont Supreme Court §6(g)(1), the undersigned hereby applies for admission by pursuing the study of law for a period of not less than four years within this state under the supervision of an attorney who has been admitted to practice before the Vermont Supreme Court for a period of not less than three years.

An applicant must be a citizen of the United States or an alien who has been lawfully admitted for permanent residence, at least eighteen years of age, of good moral character and fitness, and who has successfully completed three-quarters of the work accepted for a bachelor's degree in a college approved by the Court.
