STIPULATED PUBLIC REPRIMAND WITH ORDER

Based on the stipulation of the parties, which Assistant Judge Constance Ramsey is not contesting, the Vermont Judicial Conduct Board finds that there is clear and convincing evidence that Judge Ramsey, while serving as an Assistant Judge for Chittenden County in 2018, violated Canon 1, Rule 1.1, and Rule 1.2 of the Vermont Code of Judicial Conduct for the reasons set forth in the Stipulated Formal Complaint and incorporated herein. Based on these findings, the Judicial Conduct Board issues this Public Reprimand to Assistant Judge Ramsey for violating Canon 1, Rule 1.1 and Rule 1.2 of the Vermont Code of Judicial Conduct.

This decision with Public Reprimand is final, subject to review by the Vermont Supreme Court under Rules 10(3) and 12(3) of the Rules for Disciplinary Control of Judges.
