1. **Special Counsel for the Judicial Conduct Board has filed a Formal Complaint against you.**

2. **The Rules for Disciplinary Control of Judges, Rule 7(4) states:**

A Formal Complaint shall consist of a short and plain statement of the charges against the judge and the alleged facts upon which the complaint is based, and shall advise the judge of the right to file a written answer within twenty-one days of service, to be represented by counsel, to cross-examine witnesses, and to produce evidence on the judge's behalf.

3. **In addition, the Rules for Disciplinary Control of Judges, Rule 9(1) states:**

Within twenty-one days of service of a Formal Complaint, the judge may file an answer with the Board. The answer shall contain all defenses. No further pleadings need be filed. Failure to answer or to deny misconduct or disability shall be deemed an admission of the charges. The Chair may permit late filing of an answer upon a showing of mistake, inadvertence, surprise, or excusable neglect.
