Rule 9(4) of the Rules for Disciplinary Control of Judges states:

Discovery shall be permitted as provided for in the Rules of Civil Procedure. No materials made confidential by Rule 6.(7) shall be discoverable, and no depositions may be taken of Board members or counsel to the Board. However, all records reviewed by the Board in its initial inquiry shall be discoverable. This shall not be construed to make public any communications among Board members, the Board and special or disciplinary counsel, or other records otherwise made confidential by law or rule.

Rule 9(5) of the Rules for Disciplinary Control of Judges states:

Upon the filing of an answer or upon the expiration of the time for its filing, the Board shall set a deadline for any discovery. The evidentiary hearing shall be held before a hearing panel consisting of at least five members of the Board, at least one of whom shall be a lay member. The Board shall set a time and place for the hearing and shall give notice of the hearing to the judge at least twenty days prior to the hearing date. The Chair shall name the hearing panel and shall preside or designate a member to serve as the presiding officer.

The Reporters Notes for the 2011 Amendment states Section 5 is amended to add a period for discovery if the judge desires it.

If the Respondent Judge desires discovery, please submit a mutually agreed upon Discovery and Pre-trial Order by October 15, 2021. A blank form is attached for your convenience. If nothing is filed by that date the Chair will set a time and place for the hearing pursuant to Rule 9(5) of the Rules for Disciplinary Control of Judges.
