Respondent Stuart Jay Robinson, a lawyer licensed to practice in Vermont, is the subject of several disciplinary proceedings. He has alleged in the course of those proceedings that he is unable to assist in his defense due to a physical disability. Pursuant to A.O. 9, Rule 25(B), respondent is immediately transferred to disability inactive status pending determination of the incapacity by a PRB hearing panel. The hearing panel assigned by the Board to determine the incapacity may order respondent to be examined by a qualified medical expert either sua sponte or on motion by Special Disciplinary Counsel.
