The deadline is generally 14 days after the day the motion was hand delivered, emailed or mailed to you (not the date you received it.) Some situations have different deadlines. See Vermont Rule of Civil Procedure 7 for more information.
- On the same day you file this form with the court, you must hand deliver, email, or mail a copy to the other party or to their attorney, if they have one. You must also file a Certificate of Service (form 600-00264, [www.vermontjudiciary.org/media/11](http://www.vermontjudiciary.org/media/11)) with the court saying you did so.
- Attend the hearing if one is scheduled.

If you do not file a response by the deadline and if you do not attend a scheduled hearing, the other party's request may be granted.
