Closure Report of the Vermont Judicial Conduct Board

This is Complainant's second complaint arising from a long running foreclosure matter. The foreclosure suit has been pending since 2011 and multiple judges have presided over the varying issues in the case. Complainant has filed numerous pleadings, generally *pro se*, and the docket sheet itself is 18+ pages. Complaint's second Complaint is against a different Judge from the first complaint although the allegations are the same. Complainant is unhappy with rulings adverse to her position, concludes that adverse decisions are *per se* evidence of bias and therefore wants the Judge recused. Recusal motions have been denied by the Chief Administrative Judge.

The Judicial Conduct Board conducted an initial inquiry. To the extent the Complaint alleges ethical impropriety or a violation of the Code of Judicial Conduct, the Board has determined that the Complaint is unfounded and there is no cause for further proceedings. *Rules of the Supreme Court for the Disciplinary Control of Judges*, Rule 11.

The Complaint in Docket No. 16.012 is DISMISSED.
