MOTION TO RECONSIDER AND EXTEND
SCHEDULING ORDER DATED JANUARY 8TH

On Friday, January 8, Hearing Panel 2 issued a Scheduling Order dated January 8, 2021. The Scheduling Order, at ¶ 1, requires Respondent to respond to Disciplinary Counsel's requests for production nine (9) days ago. The January 8th Scheduling Order also requires the parties to exchange the names and information of all persons having knowledge of relevant facts and/or of witnesses nine (9) days ago. Respondent cannot comply because the dates have passed and it is impossible to timely comply. Respondent requests Hearing Panel 2 extend all dates by 30 days so that Respondent can have time to fairly responde. Respondent's counsel cannot communicate with Respondent until next week. It will take at least a week to schedule a meeting go through the file with Respondent. The soonest Counsel for the Respondent could meet with the Respondent would be January 14th, with no assurance that Respondent is also available on that date.

WHEREFORE, respondent respectfully requests all dates in the January 8th Scheduling Order be extended by 30 days to allow Respondent sufficient time to respond.
