## POST-TRIAL SCHEDULING ORDER FOR FILING OF PROPOSED FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

This Hearing Panel intends to issue a final decision in this matter within 60 days of the last filed Proposed Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law.
