REMOTE HEARINGS: UNLESS YOU KNOW/EXPECT TO HAVE A CHANGE OF PLEA, PARTIES ARE NOT REQUIRED TO APPEAR IN PERSON. IF YOUR HEARING IS A REMOTE HEARING, YOU MUST FILE A MOTION TO APPEAR IN PERSON 3 BUSINESS DAYS PRIOR TO THE HEARING.

IN PERSON HEARINGS: UNLESS A WAIVER OF APPEARANCE HAS BEEN FILED AND GRANTED OR A MOTION TO APPEAR REMOTELY HAS BEEN FILED AND GRANTED, PARTIES ARE ALL EXPECTED TO BE PRESENT IN PERSON.

Exhibits: for remote hearings, the filing of exhibits remains as is, which is 7 days prior to the hearing date. For in person hearings, they can be filed at the hearing in the court room. You may also still file them in advance if you so choose, but it will not be required.
