DECLARATORY JUDGMENT

The Court having made Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Orders on December 2, 2002, February 26, 2003, May 28, 2003, August 2, 2004, and July 15, 2005,

It is hereby DECREED:

- 1. That Defendant Henry W. Ferry is the holder of an easement appurtenant to a parcel of land in Calais known as the Scribner woodlot, conveyed to Henry Ferry by deed of Charles F. Scribner, Patricia L. Bouchard, and Diane E. Scribner dated May 25, 2000. The easement is twelve feet wide, and the course of it is as shown from point A to point B to point C as shown on the attached Exhibit A.
- 2. Howard Fletcher is ENJOINED from interfering with the quiet enjoyment of the use of the easement by Henry Ferry for the benefit of the Scribner woodlot.
- 3. Henry Ferry is ENJOINED from interfering with the quiet enjoyment by Howard Fletcher of his lands and premises on Moscow Woods Road, other than use of the easement as described in Paragraph 1.
- 4. Howard Fletcher is the holder of an easement appurtenant to a parcel of land in Calais conveyed to him by Harriet Ross and Jo Ann Ross on November 19, 1989. The easement provides access from the Fletcher parcel to the Moscow Woods Road across a parcel of land conveyed to Henry Ferry along the Moscow Woods Road on January 5, 2000.
- 5. Henry Ferry is ENJOINED from interfering with the quiet enjoyment of the use of the easement by Howard Fletcher for access to the Fletcher parcel.
