Closure Report of the Vermont Judicial Conduct Board

Re: Docket No. 16.015

This Complaint is the result of Complainant's unhappiness with the results of a foreclosure action and references the actions of three different trial judges. The Complaint failed to identify the unethical conduct of any Judge. The focus of the Complaint was an allegation that the Court lacked subject matter jurisdiction over foreclosure actions, and a copy of the Vermont Constitution is supplied to this Board in support of that theory. Complainant was given thirty days to supplement the filing with some specific allegations of ethical misconduct but failed to do so.

The Judicial Conduct Board conducted an initial inquiry. To the extent the Complaint alleges ethical impropriety or a violation of the Code of Judicial Conduct, the Board has determined that the Complaint is unfounded and there is no cause for further proceedings. *Rules of the Supreme Court for the Disciplinary Control of Judges*, Rule 11.

The Complaint in Docket No. 16.015 is DISMISSED.
