CLOSURE REPORT OF THE VERMONT JUDICIAL CONDUCT BOARD

Re: Docket No.: 18.018


This Complaint is the result of a family court hearing that was rescheduled on the day of the planned hearing when both parties were present and the Complainant stated that the parties had conferred and agreed the hearing could proceed.

The Judicial Conduct Board conducted an Initial Inquiry including a review of the docket, the particular circumstances of why the hearing got rescheduled, and the Judge's response. This inquiry showed that one of the parties had not received proper notice as required, and that was the reason the hearing was rescheduled.

To the extent the Complaint alleges ethical impropriety or a violation of the Code of Judicial Conduct, the Board has determined that the Complaint is unfounded and there is no cause for further proceedings. *Rules of the Supreme Court for the Disciplinary Control of Judges*, Rule 11.

Accordingly, the Complaint in Docket No. 18.018 is DISMISSED.
