


In the above-entitled cause, the Clerk will enter:

The respondent, Alan Sheredy, is a lawyer licensed to practice law in the State of Vermont. Disciplinary Counsel has filed with the Court a Petition for Interim Suspension status due to a medical condition that currently prevents respondent from practicing law. Attorney James W. Swift has entered a notice of appearance on behalf of attorney Sheredy. He reviewed the filings in this matter with attorney Sheredy's family, and they agree that the proposed interim suspension order is appropriate under the circumstances. Based upon the parties' agreement, and this Court's review of the petition and accompanying affidavits, we conclude that respondent's current medical condition prevents him from practicing law. We hereby order that he be transferred to interim suspension status in accordance with Administrative Order 9, Rule 18. The Court appoints Edward B. French, Esq., as Trustee in accordance with Administrative Order 9, Rule 24. Attorney French shall take action as seems indicated to protect the interests of respondent and respondent's clients, including compliance with the requirements of Administrative Order 9, Rule 23, to the extent applicable.




