**Motion to Admit Summaries of Pamela Binette's Payment Records Prepared by Respondent's Bookkeeper**

Disciplinary Counsel moves to admit reports summarizing Pamela Binette's pay while she worked in Respondent's Law Office. The reports, which are attached as DC20 -22, were generated at the request of Disciplinary Counsel and the Chair during Disciplinary Counsel efforts to cross-examine Respondent's bookkeeper, Nekol Pyle, over the telephone on November 16, 2017. Transcript, Volume III, 734:21-25 – Tr. 735: 1-22

Ms. Pyle generated these reports on November 16 and sent them to Attorney McGee, who sent them to Disciplinary Counsel the following day. The records were described by Ms. Pyle as:

- DC20 – This report shows, among other things, that Ms. Binette received a paycheck on ten dates over the period she worked for Respondent (January 2012 – January 25, 2013, that these paychecks came at 4-week to 7-week intervals, and that Ms. Binette received total gross pay of \$13, 154.75 over the approximately one year that Ms. Binette worked in Respondent's law office, first as a legal secretary, and later, as a "legal assistant."
- DC 21 – This report shows, among other things, that Ms. Binette received net pay of \$8,345.55 over the approximately one year she worked for Respondent.
- DC-22 - This report shows, among other things, that Ms. Binette received six paycheck "advances," which totaled \$2,200 over the approximately one year she worked for Respondent.

These reports are relevant because, among other things, they tend to support Ms. Binette's claim that Respondent controlled her "financial independence." This, in turn, makes it less likely that Ms. Binette voluntarily/ willingly signed the "Notice of Intent to Engage in a Mutually Welcomed Romantic Relationship and Waiver of Claims (Waiver)" (DC 5) as Respondent has claimed.
