

In the above-entitled cause, the Clerk will enter:


Disciplinary counsel and respondent have filed with the Court a stipulation to transfer respondent to disability inactive status due to a medical condition that prevents respondent from practicing law. Pursuant to an earlier stipulation of the parties and order of this Court, respondent's license to practice law has been suspended on an interim basis since July 1, 2016. Based upon the parties' stipulation and this Court's review of the accompanying evidence, the Court concludes that respondent's is incapacitated from continuing to practice law. We hereby order that respondent be transferred to disability inactive status in accordance with Administrative Order 9, Rule 21. Respondent shall comply with the requirements of Administrative Order 9, Rule 23, to the extent applicable.
