


In the above-entitled cause, the Clerk will enter:

The respondent, Alan Sheredy, is a lawyer licensed to practice law in the State of Vermont. On April 25, 2017, he was placed on interim suspension status due to a medical condition that prevented him from practicing law. Disciplinary Counsel and respondent have now filed with the Court a stipulation to transfer respondent to disability inactive status due to respondent's ongoing medical condition that continues to incapacitate respondent from practicing law. Based upon the parties' stipulation, we conclude that respondent is incapacitated from continuing to practice law. We hereby order that respondent's license be transferred to disability inactive status in accordance with Administrative Order 9, Rule 21(C).


