

In the above-entitled cause, the Clerk will enter:

The respondent, Amy Klingler, is a lawyer licensed to practice law in the State of Vermont. Disciplinary Counsel and Respondent jointly filed with the Court a Petition for Interim Suspension status due to a medical condition that currently prevents respondent from practicing law. Having reviewed the petition and the accompanying affidavit, the Court concludes that respondent's current medical condition prevents her from practicing law, and hereby orders that she be transferred to interim suspension status in accordance with Administrative Order 9, Rule 18. 
