SCHEDULING ORDER AND NOTICE OF HEARING

The Hearing Panel hereby issues the following Scheduling Order and Notice of Hearing in the above matter:

1. The parties shall exchange the names and addresses of all persons having knowledge of relevant facts and/or of witnesses by January 7, 2019.
2. Requests for production of documents shall be served by January 7, 2019 and responses shall be served by January 21, 2019.
3. The parties shall disclose any expert witnesses by January 15, 2019.
4. The parties shall disclose any rebuttal expert witnesses by February 8, 2019.
5. All depositions shall be completed by March 1, 2019.
6. All discovery, including all discovery relating to the issue of sanctions, shall be completed by March 1, 2019.
7. All pre-hearing motions, including any motions in limine, shall be filed by March 15, 2019.
8. On or before April 1, 2019, each party shall file a witness list identifying each witness the party anticipates calling to testify during the merits hearing, along with a brief summary of each witness's anticipated testimony and an estimate of the amount of time that will be needed for direct examination.
9. On or before April 1, 2019, the parties shall jointly file a consolidated list of all exhibits the parties anticipate offering into evidence at the merits hearing and indicating whether the parties will stipulate to the admission of any exhibit. At the merits hearing, the parties shall

provide the Panel with four copies of each exhibit that is admitted into evidence, in addition to the original admitted exhibit. Prior to commencement of the merits hearing, the parties shall mark all exhibits they intend to offer into evidence at the hearing.

10. The merits hearing in the above matter will be held in the Champlain Room, located at the Costello Courthouse, 32 Cherry Street, Burlington, Vermont, on May 2, 2019, commencing at 8:30 a.m. Please be advised that the Respondent is entitled to be represented by a lawyer, to cross-examine witnesses, and to present evidence.
