

In the above-entitled cause, the Clerk will enter:



Pursuant to an earlier order of this Court, respondent's license to practice law has been suspended on an interim basis since December 29, 2016, pending final disposition of an ongoing disciplinary proceeding. The Court concludes that respondent is incapacitated from continuing to practice law, and therefore, pursuant to the provisions of Administrative Order 9, Rule 21, orders as follows:


1. Respondent is hereby transferred to disability inactive status pending further order of the Court.
2. The trustee, appointed on December 29, 2016, shall comply with the provision of Administrative Order 9, Rule 23, to the extent applicable.
