

Judicial Statistics

Administrative Order No. 1 is amended to read as follows effective September 1, 2004 (new matter underlined, deleted matter overstruck):

Pursuant to the provisions of ~~4 V.S.A. § 21 and 20~~ the Vermont Constitution, Ch. II, Section 30, for the purpose of improving the administration of justice, the Court Administrator is hereby directed to ~~initiate and implement as of January 1, 1970~~ maintain and oversee a system of mandatory reporting of judicial statistics for the Supreme Court, the ~~County Superior Courts, Courts of Chancery,~~ the Probate Courts, the District Court, ~~of Vermont, the Juvenile Courts and the Small Claims Courts~~ the Family Court, the Environmental Court and the Vermont Judicial Bureau.

Such statistics shall include, but need not be limited to, number of cases entered, disposed and pending by type, age and method of disposition, the Court Administrator will determine the frequency of such reports and shall provide the necessary forms to be used in reporting such judicial statistics to the clerks and registers of the various courts.

The Court Administrator shall make an annual report of judicial statistics to the Supreme Court.
