Closure Report of the Vermont Judicial Conduct Board

Re: Docket No. 11.026

The Complaint arose out of a multi-jurisdictional guardianship matter involving Complaint's brother. The Complainant's main concerns have to do with the decisions made by the Judge, which are subject to appellate review and do not raise ethical issues. There are also concerns raised about the competence and ethics of an attorney appointed as Trustee, which are matters outside the jurisdiction of this Board.

The Judicial Conduct Board conducted an initial inquiry including review of the complaint with its multiple attachments and the docket sheet from the Court. To the extent the Complaint alleges ethical impropriety or a violation of the Code of Judicial Conduct, the Board has determined that the Complaint is unfounded and there is no cause for further proceedings. *Rules of the Supreme Court for the Disciplinary Control of Judges*, Rule 7(1).

The Complaint in Docket No. 11.026 is DISMISSED.
