Closure Report of the Vermont Judicial Conduct Board

Re: Docket No. 12.034

This Complaint stems from dissatisfaction with the outcome of hearings before more than one judge, dealing generally with child custody and relief from abuse petitions. Complainant appears to seek assistance from the Judicial Conduct Board in having the rulings overturned. This is not the role of the Judicial Conduct Board. The Complaint alleged a violation of Canon 3(B).

The Judicial Conduct Board conducted an initial inquiry and determined the Complaint is unfounded and there is no cause for further proceedings.
