Closure Report of the Vermont Judicial Conduct Board

Re: Docket No. 12.040

This Complaint is the result of a termination of parental rights case. Complainant is unhappy with her current attorney. She has dismissed two other attorneys. The Complaint alleged a general violation of Canon 3 although the substance of the complaint dealt with dissatisfaction with Complainant's attorney rather than judicial conduct.

The Judicial Conduct Board conducted an initial inquiry including a review of the pleadings and orders filed by the parties in the Court. To the extent the Complaint alleges ethical impropriety or a violation of the Code of Judicial Conduct, the Board has determined that the Complaint is unfounded and there is no cause for further proceedings. *Rules of the Supreme Court for the Disciplinary Control of Judges*, Rule 7(1).

The Complaint in Docket No. 12.040 is DISMISSED.
