## Closure Report of the Vermont Judicial Conduct Board

Re: Docket No. 12.046

This Complaint is the result of a Probate matter dealing with settling an Estate. Complainant is unhappy with the executor of the Estate, the executor's attorney and ultimately with the results of a hearing. Complainant alleges that the Judge did not treat him fairly, did not accord him due process and acted inappropriately. Canon 2B(4) deals with Judicial temperament

The Judicial Conduct Board conducted an initial inquiry including a review of the pleadings and orders filed by the parties in the Court, as well as a review of the audio tapes of the hearings. To the extent the Complaint alleges ethical impropriety or a violation of the Code of Judicial Conduct, the Board has determined that the Complaint is unfounded and there is no cause for further proceedings. *Rules of the Supreme Court for the Disciplinary Control of Judges*, Rule 11.

The Complaint in Docket No. 12.046 is DISMISSED.
