Closure Report of the Vermont Judicial Conduct Board

Re: Docket No. 13.012

Complainant is involved in multiple lawsuits. The same Judge handled four of the lawsuits. This Complaint is the result of Complainant's unhappiness with the Judge's decisions. Complainant alleges the Judge "was not faithful to the law," the Judge was biased, the Judge had "ex parte" knowledge and the Judge was not prompt, efficient or fair. Complainant alleges various violations of the Code including violations of Canon 3(B)(2)(5)(7) & (8).

The Judicial Conduct Board conducted an initial inquiry including a review of the pleadings and orders filed by the parties in the Court. To the extent the Complaint alleges ethical impropriety or a violation of the Code of Judicial Conduct, the Board has determined that the Complaint is unfounded and there is no cause for further proceedings. *Rules of the Supreme Court for the Disciplinary Control of Judges*, Rule 11.

The Complaint in Docket No. 13.012 is DISMISSED.
