Closure Report of the Vermont Judicial Conduct Board

Re: Docket No. 14.013

Complainant alleges that certain courtrooms in Vermont are not fully compliant with the Americans With Disabilities Act and asks the Judicial Conduct Board to discipline the Assistant Judges for this alleged breach. Complainant also asks the Board to intercede in pending hearings. The Complaint was initially dismissed for failure to allege facts which are violations of the Code of Judicial Ethics. Complainant then filed a Motion for Reconsideration which reargues the same issues.

The Judicial Conduct Board conducted an initial inquiry. To the extent the Complaint alleges ethical impropriety or a violation of the Code of Judicial Conduct, the Board has determined that the Complaint is unfounded and there is no cause for further proceedings. *Rules of the Supreme Court for the Disciplinary Control of Judges*, Rule 11.

The Complaint in Docket No. 14.013 is DISMISSED.
