Closure Report of the Vermont Judicial Conduct Board

Re: Docket No. 14.046

This Complaint alleges prejudice and bias of an unnamed judge. It fails to provide the name of a court or a case docket number. It also is completely devoid of any specific allegations of unethical conduct or bias. The focus of the Complaint is a request for information concerning assigned counsel, State's Attorneys, judicial assignments and other research requests. Complainant was provided with information about the filing of ethical complaints and given thirty days to supplement the filing with some specific allegations but has failed to do so.

The Judicial Conduct Board conducted an initial inquiry. To the extent the Complaint alleges ethical impropriety or a violation of the Code of Judicial Conduct, the Board has determined that the Complaint is unfounded and there is no cause for further proceedings. *Rules of the Supreme Court for the Disciplinary Control of Judges*, Rule 11.

The Complaint in Docket No. 14.012 is DISMISSED.
