Closure Report of the Vermont Judicial Conduct Board

Re: Docket No. 15.001

This Complaint is the result of non specific allegations which failed to identify the unethical conduct of the Judge. Complainant believes the Windham County Court erred in finding he violated a traffic law, and then on appeal, by reaching a conclusion that he believes is not factually supported. Complainant was given thirty days to supplement the filing with some specific allegations of ethical misconduct, rather than of an adverse decision, but failed to do so.

The Judicial Conduct Board conducted an initial inquiry. To the extent the Complaint alleges ethical impropriety or a violation of the Code of Judicial Conduct, the Board has determined that the Complaint is unfounded and there is no cause for further proceedings. *Rules of the Supreme Court for the Disciplinary Control of Judges*, Rule 11.

The Complaint in Docket No. 145.001 is DISMISSED.
