Closure Report of the Vermont Judicial Conduct Board

Re: Docket No. 12.035

Complainant filed a *pro se* personal injury action against multiple parties, including the State of Vermont and the Office of Child Support. Multiple hearings occurred over a two year period, with ruling often adverse to Complainant, in part attributable to Complainant's unfamiliarity with the Rules of Civil Procedure. Complainant then brought the instant complaints of bias by one or more judges, alleging violations of Canons 3(B)(4) & (5).

The Judicial Conduct Board conducted an initial inquiry and determined the Complaint is unfounded and there is no cause for further proceedings. To the extent the Complaint alleges ethical impropriety or a violation of the Code of Judicial Conduct, the Board has determined that the Complaint is unfounded and there is no cause for further proceedings. *Rules of the Supreme Court for the Disciplinary Control of Judges*, Rule 7(1).

The Complaint in Docket No. 12.035 is DISMISSED.
