**The Bar of the Vermont Supreme Court  
Fees for Bar Admissions and Attorney Licensing**

In exercise of the authority given to the State Court Administrator by Rule 26 of the Rules of Admission to the Bar of the Vermont Supreme Court, Section 2(b) of Administrative Order 41, and Section 7 of Administrative Order 41, the following fee schedule is approved effective March 1, 2020.

**Bar Admissions**

- Application for admission by examination: \$300
  - Late fee: \$50
- Application for admission without examination: \$800
- Application for admission by transferred UBE score: \$525
- Nonapproved Law School Equivalency Determination: \$50 deposit

***Notes:***

- Applicants must pay all fees associated with completing the National Conference of Bar Examiners' Standard Character & Fitness Application. The fee is paid directly to the NCBE.
- Examinees who use laptops on the examination must pay an additional fee directly to the company that licenses the exam software.
- Each application fee includes a nonrefundable \$50 administrative fee.
- An applicant will be required to pay the costs of an equivalency determination that exceed the deposit.

**Law Office Study Program**


- First time registration of law office study: \$200
- Fee for filing of each six-month report: \$100

**Attorney Licensing Fees (Per Licensing Cycle)**

- Active \$420
- Inactive \$170
- Pro Bono Emeritus \$75
- Judicial \$0
- Reinstatement/Late Fee \$100
- CLE Makeup Plan \$50

This directive becomes effective March 1, 2020.
