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**Motion To Allow An Orderly Winding Down Of The Practice, And For Postponement Of Any Effective Date Until September 15, 2019 In Order To Complete An Ongoing Matter.**


Respondent herein Sigismund J Wysolmerski respectfully files the following Motion before the professional responsibility board:

1. In a decision dated July 18, 2019 the hearing panel found violations of the professional conduct rules and hearing panel six ordered suspension of the respondent for 12 months.
2. This decision indicates that the suspension to become effective immediately and under the rules respondent is entitled to appeal to the Vermont Supreme Court within a 30 day period.
3. The Vermont rules also indicate that there needs to be a winding down of any practice within 10 days after the decision becomes final.
4. Respondent has spoken with bar counsel and I am authorized to indicate that she does not oppose this motion.
5. Respondent has been actively litigating matters in the Rutland Superior Court on behalf of a client which case has been set for trial September 9, 2019. In this matter, a trial before the court Giancola et al v City of Rutland docket number 503 – 10 – 17 Rdcv, discovery has been conducted, experts have been retained and prepared, reports have been filed, and it would place the clients at a distinct disadvantage to have to change counsel at this time.

6. Respondent respectfully requests that this matter be amended to include an effective date of September 15, 2019 in order to properly wind up this matter, as well as matters before the family and criminal courts for which there are currently nine scheduled hearings.

Now therefore counsel respectfully requests that this matter be amended to declare the effective date September 15, 2019
