Respond to requests for production of documents and evidence	February 17, 2024
File motions to amend the petition of misconduct	March 1, 2024
Disclose expert witnesses	March 1, 2024
Disclose rebuttal expert witnesses	April 1, 2024
Take depositions	August 1, 2024
Complete discovery, including discovery-related motions	August 1, 2024
File objections to the hearing panel conducting the merits hearing remotely by video conferencing	May 1, 2024
File pre-hearing motions, including motions <i>in limine</i>	August 30, 2024
File a witness list identifying the witnesses the party anticipates calling to testify at the merits hearing, together with a brief summary of each witness's anticipated testimony and an estimate of the amount of time needed for direct examination, and an exhibit list identifying the exhibits the party anticipates presenting at the merits hearing, together with a representation as to whether or not the opposing party stipulates to each exhibit's authenticity or admissibility or both.	August 30, 2024
