**Emergency Order Amending § 2 of Administrative Order No. 41**

Pursuant to the Vermont Constitution, Chapter II, §§ 30, 37, it is hereby ordered:

1. That § 2 of Administrative Order No. 41 be amended as follows (new matter underlined):

**LICENSING OF ATTORNEYS**

**§ 2. License Renewal.** Upon being approved for admission to the Bar of the Vermont Supreme Court and on or before June 30 of every other year thereafter, an attorney must:

- (a) Complete, sign, and file a licensing statement with the State Court Administrator; and
- (b) Remit the licensing fee required by a fee schedule that has been approved by the State Court Administrator. The fee schedule will be approved and published no later than April 1 of each year.

For those attorneys required to renew their license for the 2021-2023 reporting period, the deadline for renewal in Section 2 is extended to August 17, 2021.

**Note—2021 Amendment**

Section 2 is revised to extend the renewal deadline for the 2021-2023 reporting period to accommodate attorneys who may be having technical issues completing the renewal through the recently implemented online attorney portal.

2. That this Order, as amended, will become effective immediately. The Board's Notes are advisory.

3. That the Chief Justice is authorized to report this amendment to the General Assembly in accordance with the provisions of 12 V.S.A. §1, as amended.
