



STANDING ORDER RE: REMOTE HEARINGS

Paragraph 5 of Administrative Order 49 concerning remote hearings was deleted effective September 6, 2022. The Reporter's Notes regarding the change provided that remote participation in civil proceedings will for now be governed by existing Rule 43.1 of the Vermont Rules of Civil Procedure, until new rules for remote proceedings are issued.

Rule 43.1 provides that by order served on all parties, a court may require remote participation, and/or that a judge may preside from a remote location. V.R.C.P. 43.1(c)(3) & (4). Until further notice, any Notice of Hearing issued in a case in this Division that specifies that a hearing is remote shall constitute the required notice.
